L.E.A.P. - LEVEL 2 (12-15)

As youth grow and engage in the youth club it becomes time for them to L.E.A.P. As 12 - 15 year olds the focus of this level is to help them Learn, Expand, Advance and Practice what they have learned through other activities. As part of this level, youth may attend Youth Weekends and Retreats, and help with organised community service. In this way youth can expand their Connections, put into practice what they have learned and move on to the next level,



L.E.A.D. - LEVEL 3 (16+)



As youth club members grow and mature, it becomes time for them to shoulder a degree of responsibility and L.E.A.D. This level will challenge our youth to Love, Enhance, Apply and Develop their leadership skills. The emphasis of this level is leadership during Youth Club, Youth Weekends and organised community service. The connection now is not simply being part of the group, but working with others and being included in leading the group.
